Winemaking:

Only the best fruit goes into La Puerta Alta, out estate grown and bottles wines. The grapes are hand-picked from drip irrigated vines which are hand pruned and canopy-managed for optimum flavor ripeness.

Once the wines are produced the best reds are carefully selected for the Alta range and kept in separate tanks until both primary and secondary fermentation is complete. Then they are aged in French and American oak barrels for 3 months.

Tasting notes:

Intense black-red color with purple hues and aromas of ripe plums. A velvety sensation and subtle character in the palate lead to a great lingering finish. Complexity of aromas and taste define the typical features of this varietal.
