“Our vineyards lie on land that hundreds of years ago was inhabited by the indigenous people of La Rioja, The Diaguitas. To honor their heritage and culture we have adopted the Puma, that in their culture represents the supreme earthly being for its wisdom, strength and intelligence.” – Valle de La Puerta

Winemaking:

Our winemaker Javier Collovati has crafted this wine by choosing premium grapes from lots that thrive in our soils: Malbec (60%), Syrah (23%), and Bonarda (17%) to create this smooth and approachable ‘big red’. True to our winemaking philosophy, the Gran Reserva is a small-lot production of the highest quality, produced only in the best vintages. 100% of the wine is aged for 12 months in French and American oak barrels. After bottling the wine is laid down to mature for another 12 months.

Tasting notes:

This wine has an intense black-red color with purple hues. Aromas full of red fruits with hints of smoke reflect its aging with oak. Complex on the palate, well structured with a lengthy finish. Its rounded tannins show their presence and give it a unique character with great balance and a multi-layered finish.
